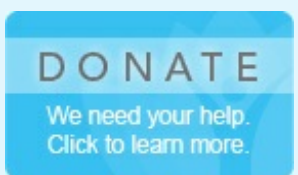

Call Now: Urge Georgia Members of
Congress to **PASS** VAWA 2019 H.R.
1585

Representative Karen Bass (D-CA-37) and Representative Brian Fitzpatrick (R-PA-1) introduced H.R. 1585, the bipartisan Violence Against Women Re-authorization Act (VAWA) of 2019. **H.R. 1585 is a modest re-authorization bill that includes narrowly focused enhancements** that address gaps identified by victims and survivors of domestic and sexual violence and the people who work on the ground with them every day.

VAWA 2019 will provide avenues to safety and justice for **ALL** victims and survivors. **Your voice is vital to ensuring that VAWA 2019 moves forward.**
